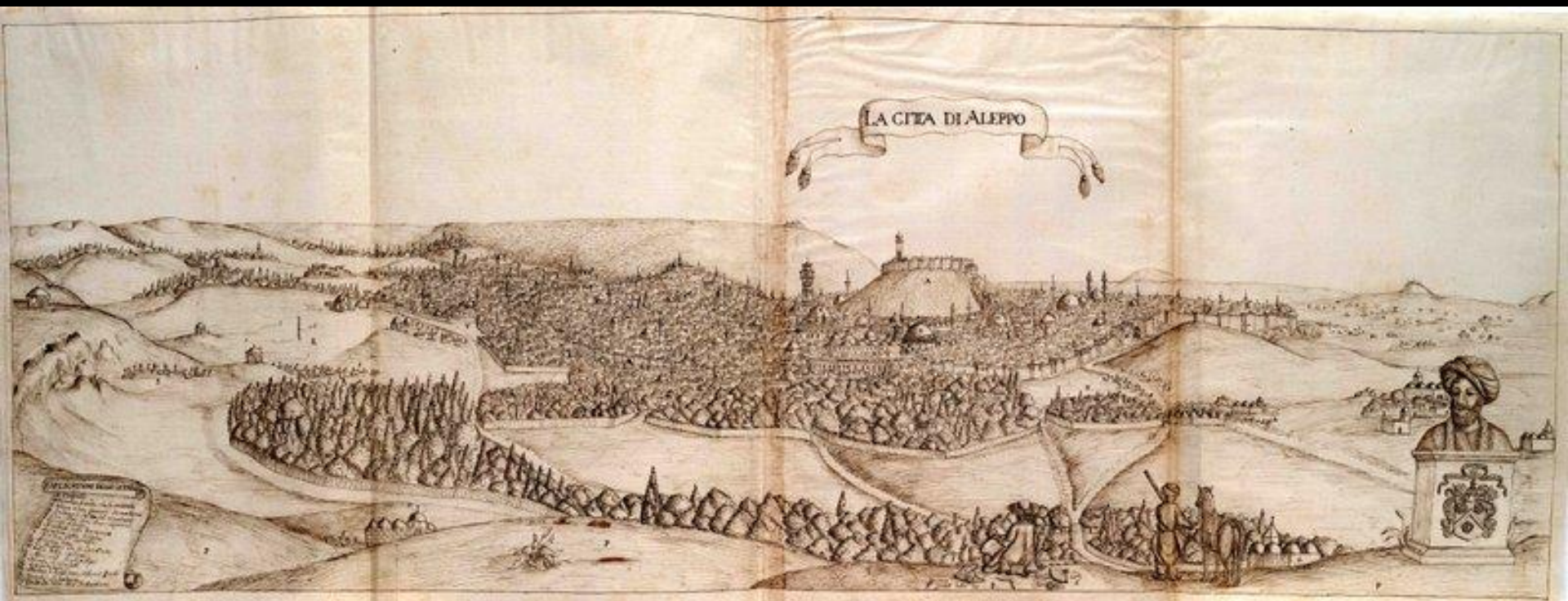

JOURNEY
FROM
Aleppo to Jerusalem;
At Easter, A. D. 1697.

THERE being several Gentlemen of our Nation (fourteen in number) determined for a visit to the *Holy-Land* at the approaching Easter, I resolv'd, tho' but newly come to *Aleppo*, to make one in the same design: considering that as it was my purpose to undertake this Pilgrimage some time or other, before my Return to *England*, so I could never do it, either with less prejudice to my Cure, or with greater pleasure to my self than at this Juncture; having so large a part of my Congregation abroad at the same time, and in my Company.

Pursuant to this resolution, we set out from *Aleppo* Friday Feb. 26. 1696. at three in the Afternoon, intending to make only a short stop that Evening in order to prove how well we were provided with necessaries for our Journey. Our Quarters this first Night we took up at the *Honey-Kane*; a place of but indifferent Accommodation, about one hour and a half West of *Aleppo*.

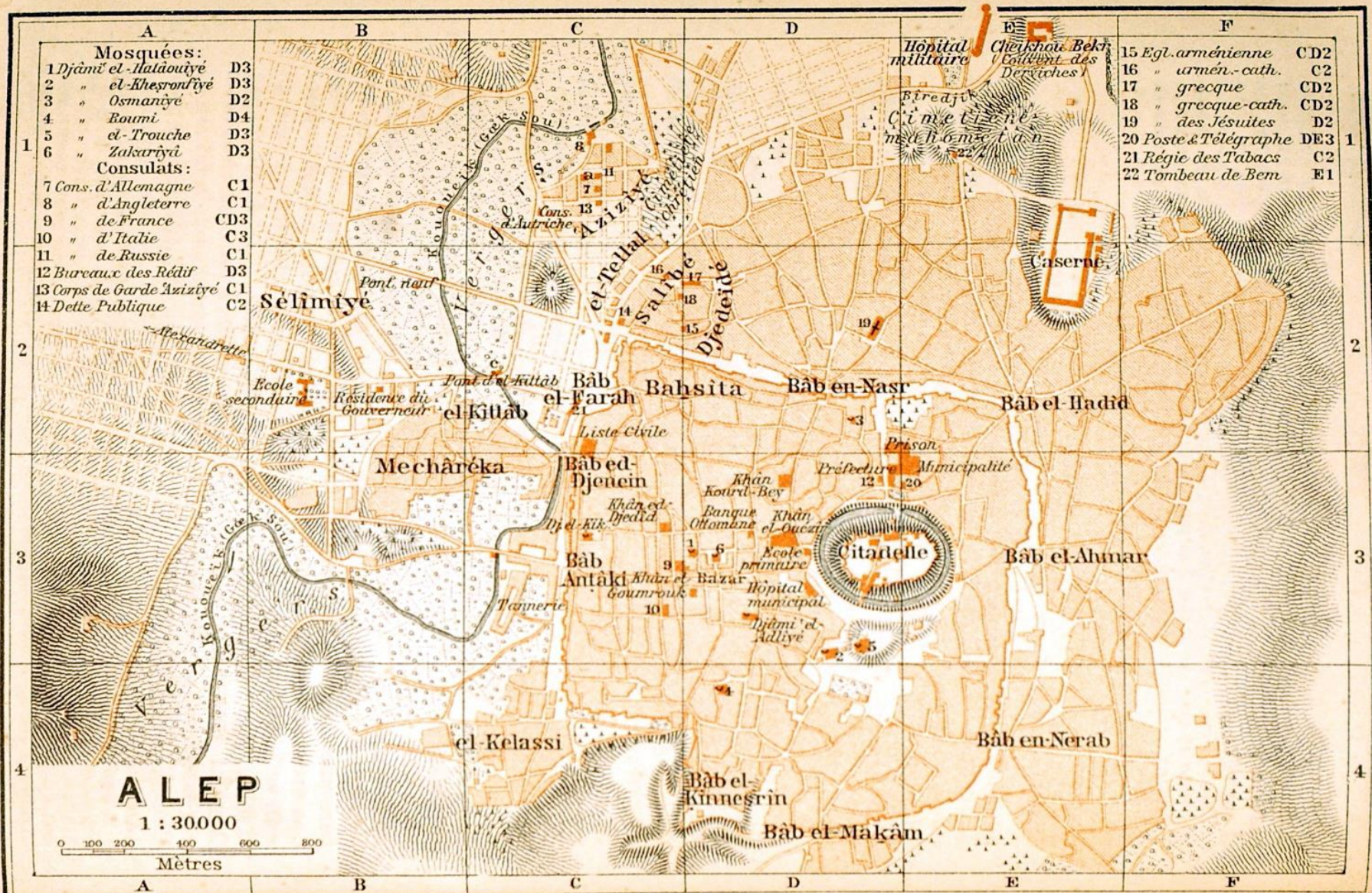

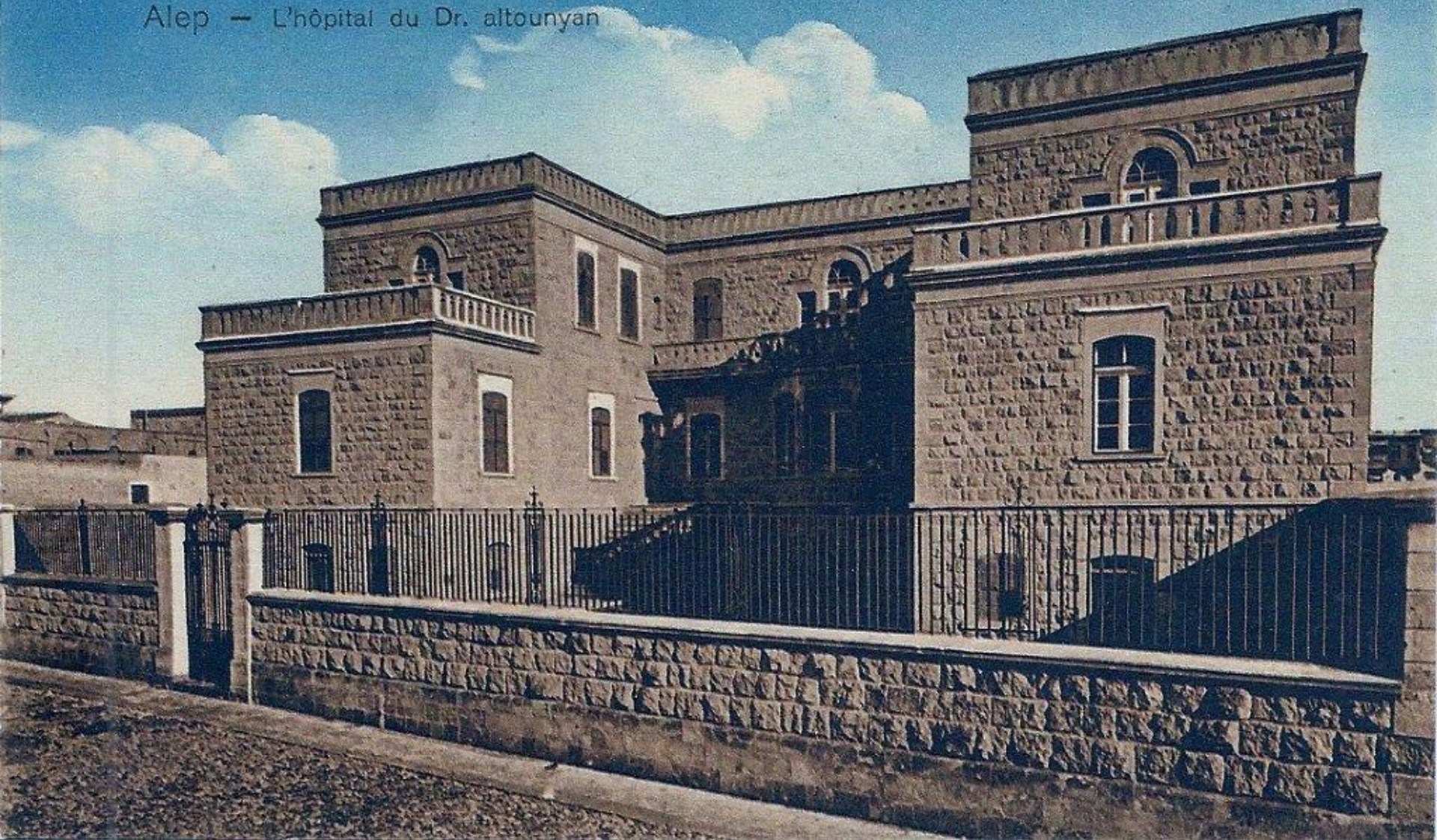

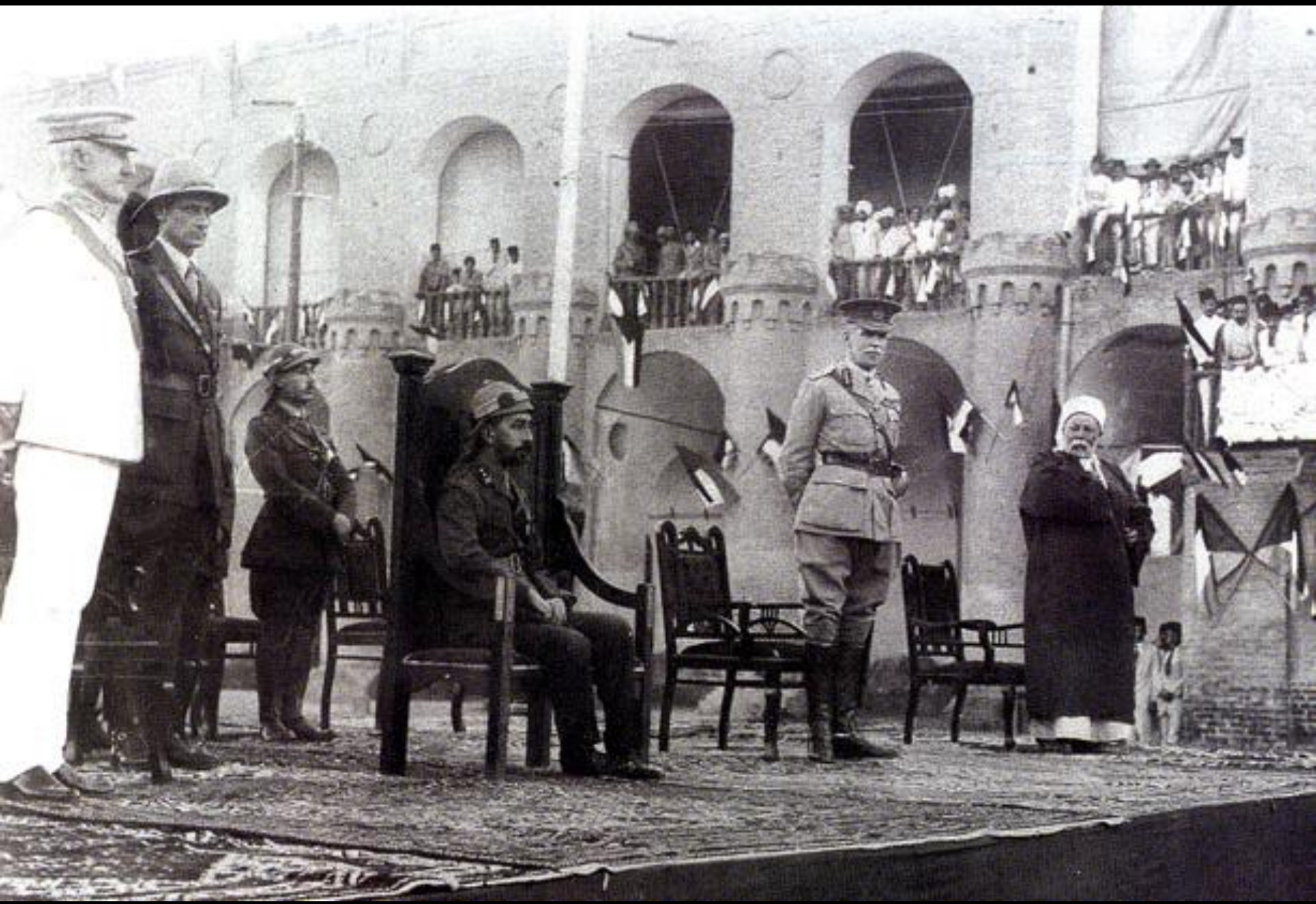
