



The Reminiscences of Geoffrey William Whittall. 1906 – 2003

Geoffrey William Whittall was born and spent his childhood in Constantinople. Exiled to Athens and Rome during the First World War, he was educated in England and qualified as a Doctor in 1930. He worked as a General Practitioner in London before and after the introduction of the National Health Service.

He served during the War in North Africa, Sicily and Italy. His marriage in 1936 to Barbara, a Russian émigré, gave him the entrée to the social life of the Russian colony in London. These reminiscences give a vivid and personal account of his life and friendships during these times.
