BRIEF HISTORY OF THE BOUDJAH CHURCH

Starting from the 17th century Smyrna gradually changed from a small and quiet west Anatolian town to a rich and cosmopolitan port and a centre of western and other cultures. Amongst the foreign traders one of the best to compete and amongst the richest were the British, though in number they were

not the most numerous. Many preferred the then probable Greek hamlets of

Boudjah [post-1927 Buca] and Bournabat [Bornova] for their summer and residential homes as they saw it as safe, quiet and healthy for their families.

The "All Saints" church was built in 1866, consecrated in 1868, replacing the chapel founded in 1835 and consecrated with the cemetery in 18432. Between 1839\endash 1925 this church had 7 consecutive ministers and after this date became the second church of the Izmir (Alsancak \endash St. John) church
