

Pasakopru cemetery listing

The following listing represents only about a quarter of the cemetery to give an impression of the nature of the burials there. The cemetery is considerably outside the centre of the city, ensuring its survival till today, and has acted as a depository for burials of Catholics whose graves have either been transferred (such as the various cemeteries of Caravan Bridge) by the various ‘nations’ or families concerned, or by persons outside ‘catchment’ areas such as Karşıyaka.

The survey is somewhat haphazard, done in a single afternoon, starting from the apex of the triangular corner facing the city of Izmir. The letters represent longitudinal rows, while the numbers increase away from the apex corner of the cemetery.
