#### The Levant: land of fascination and of conquest!

Westerners putting down roots in these lands of opportunity would live here for centuries and thus become a commercial and cultural bridge between East and West.

In his book <u>Les Levantins</u>, Olivers Jens Schmitt describes the Levantines as an "ethno-confessional supranational group". With no specific official identity of its own, this community easily embraces all cultures and religions. At the same time, Levantine individuals still retain citizenship ties with their countries of origin.

The Izmir Chamber of Commerce have accepted to host a symposium to take place from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> November 2010 in their own premises which also host a museum on the history of Izmir as a great trading centre. There will be simultaneous translation facilities into and from English, French and Turkish. The Symposium will study the history of the Levantines and consider how the past and present Levantine concept can play a role in the modern world as a model for peaceful and multicultural cohabitation. These themes and aspirations will be developed during presentations and discussions, creating fresh opportunities and a pool of ideas for new relationships.

Messrs Alex and Giancarlo Baltazzi of Karavan Travel-Turkey have kindly agreed to organize the logistics of the activities in Izmir and Istanbul. Please see approximate costs below.

Local delegates and participants staying with relatives or friends will be able to attend the meetings and activities too such as tours to Ephesus (cost 45 Euro), and Izmir sightseeing (30 Euro), Izmir & Ephesus combined 75 Euro). For Istanbul, approximate costs will be 56 Euro, including full day Istanbul sightseeing and half day Bosphorus cruise. Entrance fees, entrance tickets, meals are not included in the tours.

<u>www.levantineheritage.com</u> is an excellent source of information and photos of The Levant and Levantine families. This reunion should also bring to life these mementos, and hopefully keep alive the notion of the Levantine spirit for future generations.

The symposium will take place in Izmir, with round table meetings at the Chamber of Commerce premises full day on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> November, and sight-seeing tours on Thursday and Friday to the areas where Levantine ancestors used to live and work. We shall have the opportunity of capturing the atmosphere of a by-gone age visiting: (Alsancak) old Smyrna's "Punta", and suburbs such as Bornova (Bournabat), Buca (Boudja), Karsiyaka (Cordelio). Ephesus, and the Izmir Museum visits also recommended.

On the evening of 3<sup>rd</sup> November the Izmir Chamber of Commerce will host a reception and dinner for our speakers and hotel guests who have taken our organisers' package. For those not participating in the formal sessions there will be alternative activities such as an Izmir Bay cruise, shopping, and promenades on the new corniche and the Konak Pier.

#### The Levantines Past - Present - Future Symposium and Cultural Events in Izmir and Istanbul 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> November 2010

On Saturday 6 November, the tour will continue by air to Istanbul with several site visits in Galata and Pera, including the birthplaces of Levantine poets and artists. A Bosphorus cruise is also planned.

A list of speakers is attached. We shall do our best to accommodate other participants wishing to present a theme, or cater for contributions such as individual photo displays.

This symposium will celebrate several centuries of the Western presence in Turkey and will provide an opportunity to enjoy the experience of a unique architectural and cultural heritage. There will be no discussion of religious, political or racial issues.
